b) A Bachelor's degree with a lower second-class honors with a GPA of 2.50 on a scale of 4.00 in a business field or its equivalent with additional training, evidence of research capability either through research, paper presentation or peer reviewed publication, or

c) A Bachelor's degree with a lower second-class honors with a GPA of 2.50 on a scale of 4.00 or its equivalent and at least two years of relevant working experience.
